**A.A. Degree Transfer Performance in the SUS Report**

This measure indicates the performance of Associate in Arts graduates for 2007-08 who transferred to the State Universities System (SUS) in 2008-09. A.A. students who started at one college, transferred to another and then transferred to the State University System are not accounted for in this report. The report focuses solely on the performance of students who received their complete education from one institution. This measure will allow institutions to focus on the results of their own instructional strategies, so appropriate adjustments can be made in response to the results. Performance will be reported by the mean GPA.

### **Number Enrolled Not In Good Academic Standing**

Of the cohort, excluding the Number Graduated, the number of students still enrolled at the institution during the following terms with a GPA less than 2.0.

### **Number Graduated**

Of the cohort, the number of students who graduated.

### **Number in Pool**

The number of records with useable match data. It excludes records with exceptionalities without positive outcome data. Non-Resident Aliens, undeterminable, and unusable data, and those reported as incarcerated.
