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Definitions

Academic Year – The Academic Year (AY) includes Fall, Spring, and Summer terms of overlapping calendar years. This differs from the reporting year, which begins with summer and ends with spring. Unless otherwise indicated, the NFC Fact Book uses the Academic Year. Trends use the last 5 Academic Years.

2020-2021 Fact Book:

AY 2021 = Fall 2020, Spring 2021, Summer 2021

AY 2020 = Fall 2019, Spring 2020, Summer 2020

AY 2019 = Fall 2018, Spring 2019, Summer 2019

AY 2018 = Fall 2017, Spring 2018, Summer 2018

AY 2017 = Fall 2016, Spring 2017, Summer 2017

College Credit – The type of credit assigned to courses that are part of an organized and specified college degree or program.

Credit Hour – The number of contact hours for a course.

Dual Enrollment – Enrollment in two institutions at the same time, such as a college and high school, which allows students to earn both high school and college credit simultaneously.

Duplicated Headcount – A headcount measure by which students may be counted in more than one category. This measure usually describes the number of seats taken across multiple courses or number of degrees or certificates awarded.

First Time in College (FTIC) – A student attending college for the first time with no prior credit toward a degree or formal award.

Full-time Equivalency (FTE) – A measure to describe various cohorts of students based on the number of student credit hours generated. FTE is computed by dividing the total number of credit or clock hours by 30.

Full-time Student – A student who is registered for 12 or more credit hours in the fall and spring semesters or four or more credit hours in the summer semester.

Part-time Student – A student who is registered for less than 12 credit hours in the fall and spring terms or fewer than four credit hours in the summer term.

Reporting Year – The summer, fall, and spring terms of overlapping calendar years. For example, Summer 2020, Fall 2020, and Spring 2021 comprise the 2020-2021 reporting year. This differs from the academic year, which begins with fall and ends with summer.

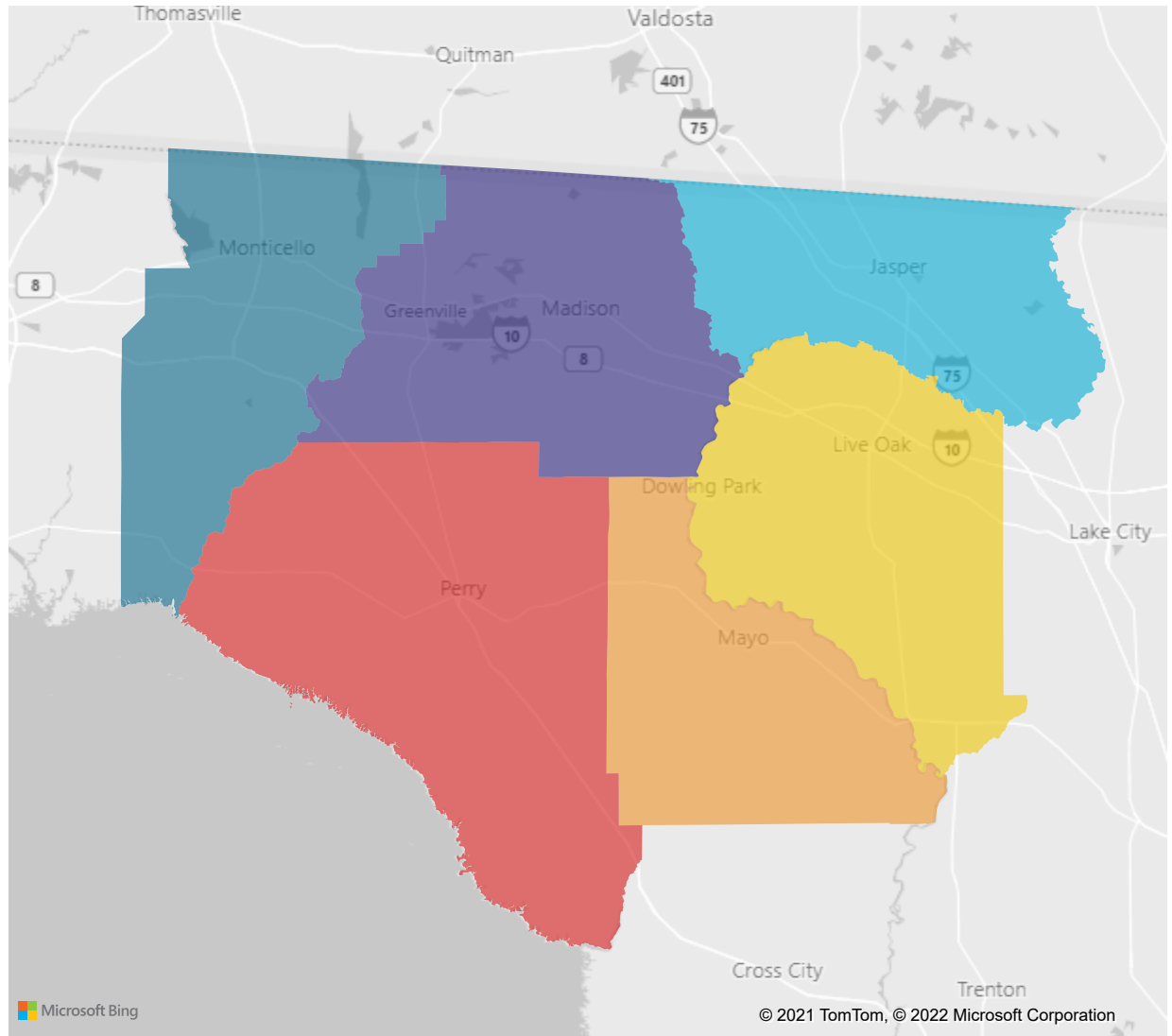
Unduplicated Headcount – A headcount measure by which students are counted in only one category.

Service Area

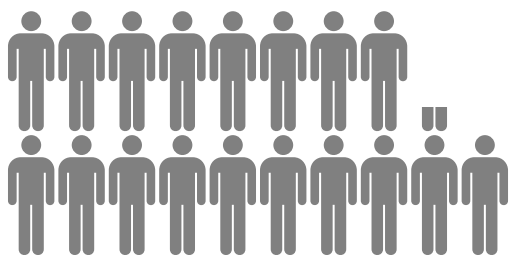
North Florida College is located in Madison, Florida at 325 NW Turner Davis Drive. Madison lies in the center of NFC's six county service area (Hamilton, Jefferson, Lafayette, Madison, Suwannee, and Taylor Counties), off of I-10 near I-75, and is near such major Florida cities as Tallahassee and Jacksonville. NFC is also just minutes away from the Georgia border and is a short distance from the Gulf of Mexico and cities bordering the Atlantic Ocean.

The City of Madison has a population of just under 3,000; Madison County's total population is close to 18,500; and NFC's six-county service area has a combined population of over 121,000 (figures based on 2020 census data from the US Census Bureau).

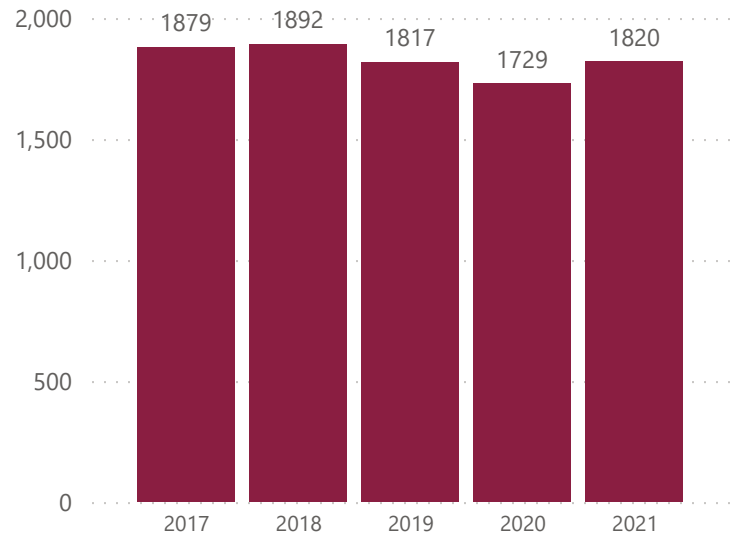

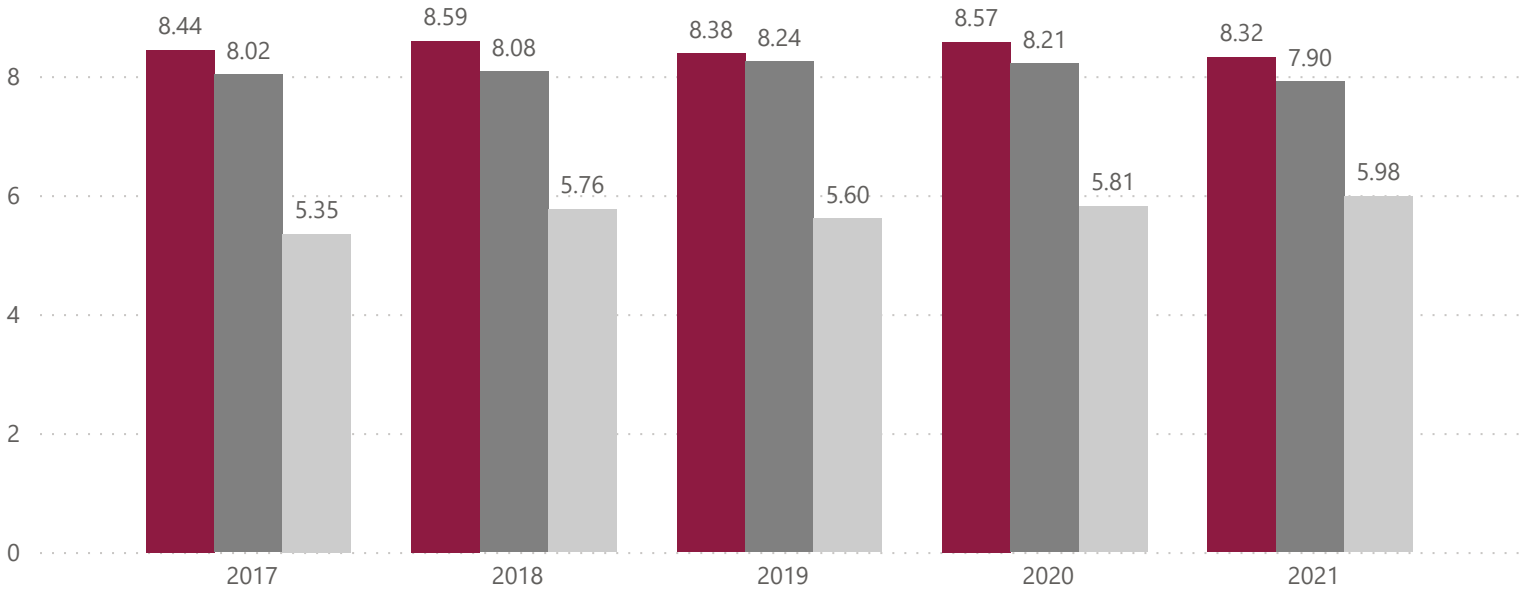


Credits Enrolled per Student

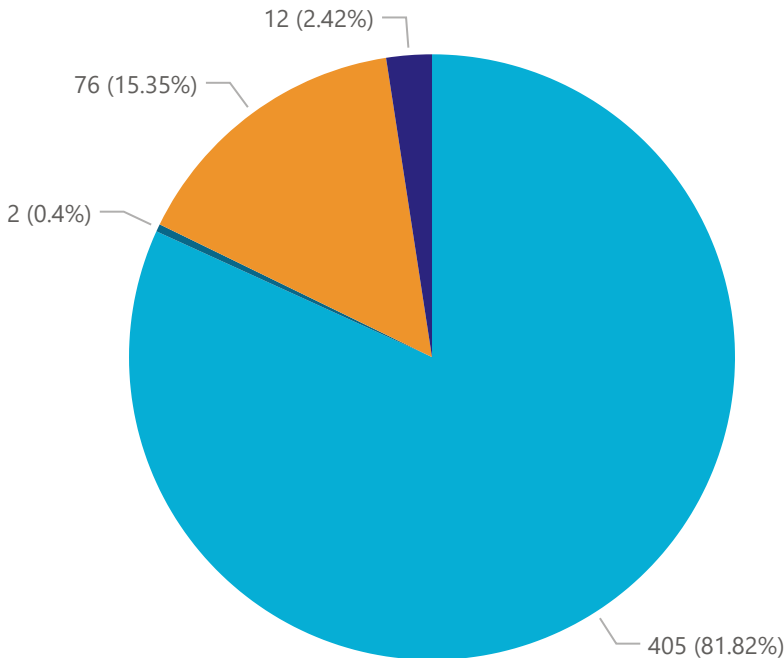

Dual Enrollment Count by Registration Status

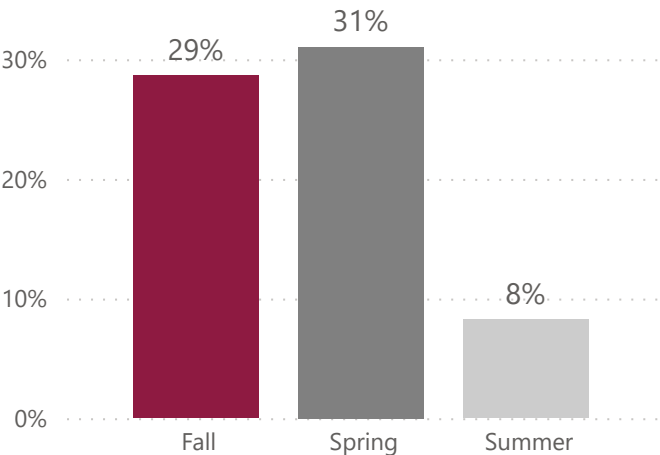

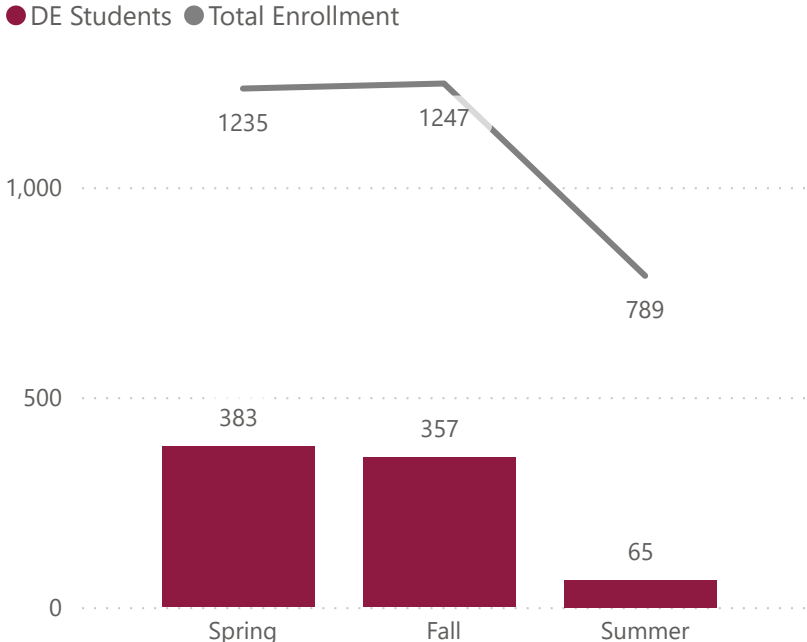

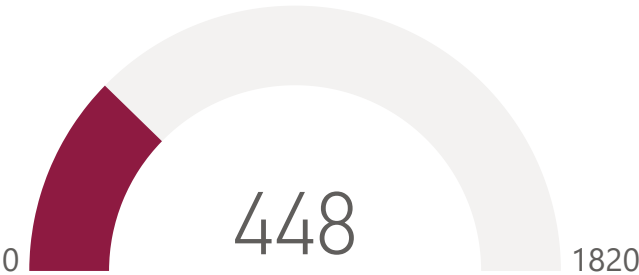

Dual Enrolled Students vs Total Enrollment

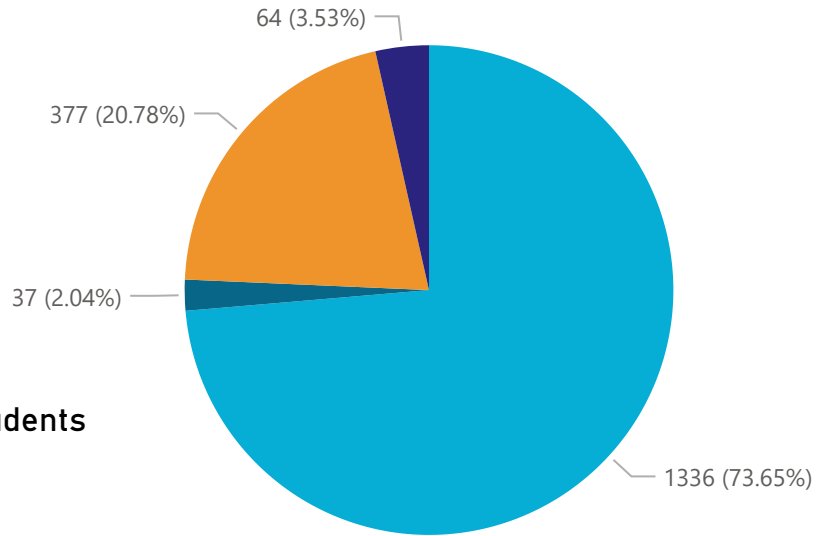

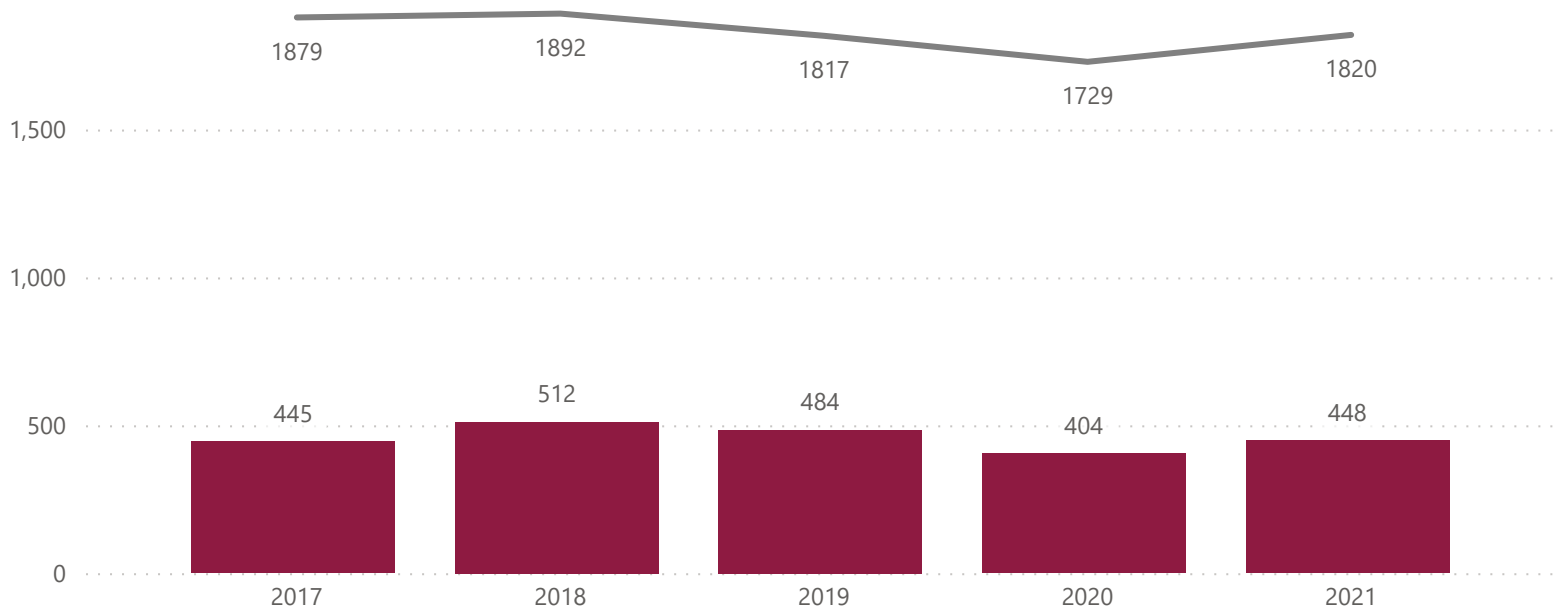

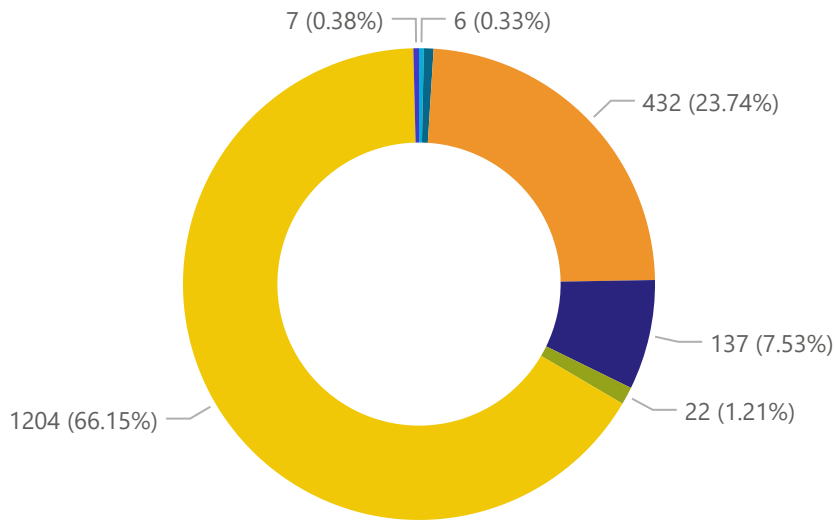

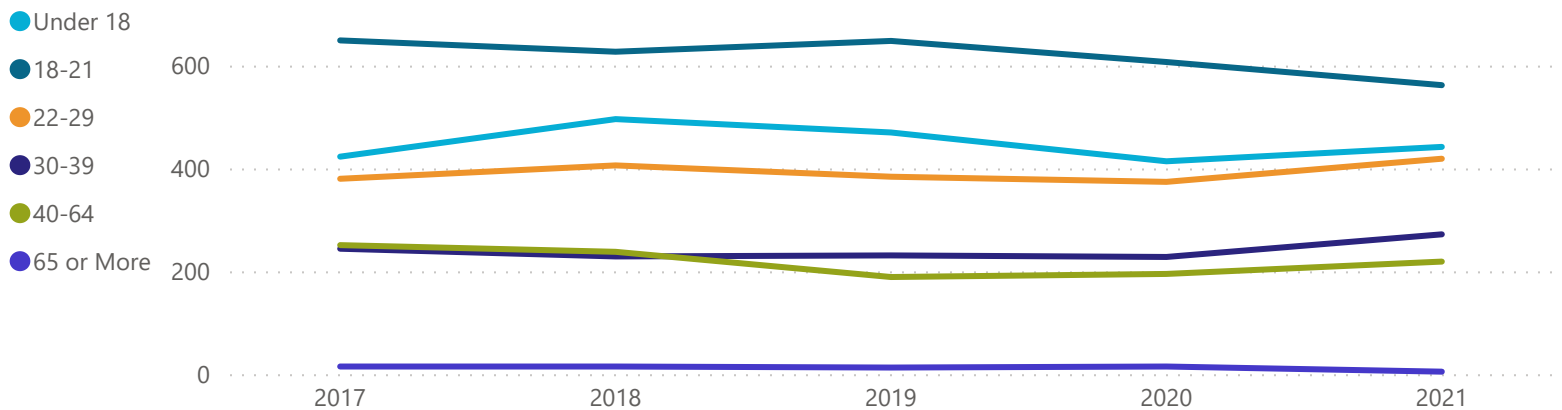

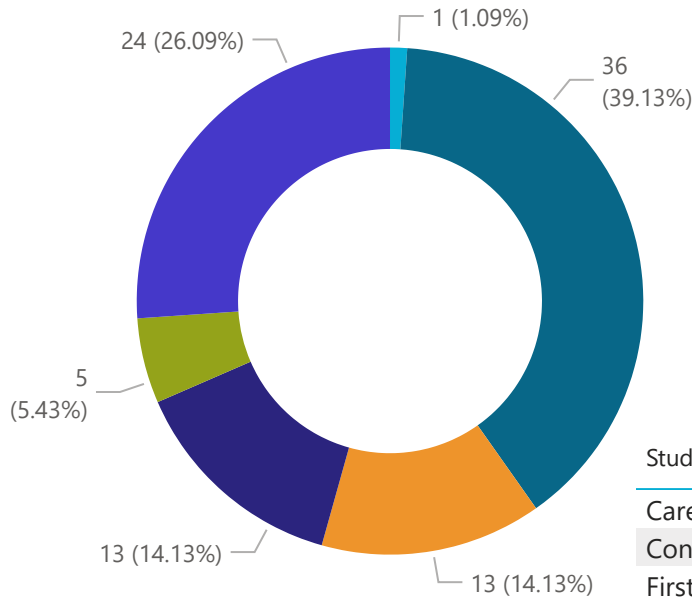

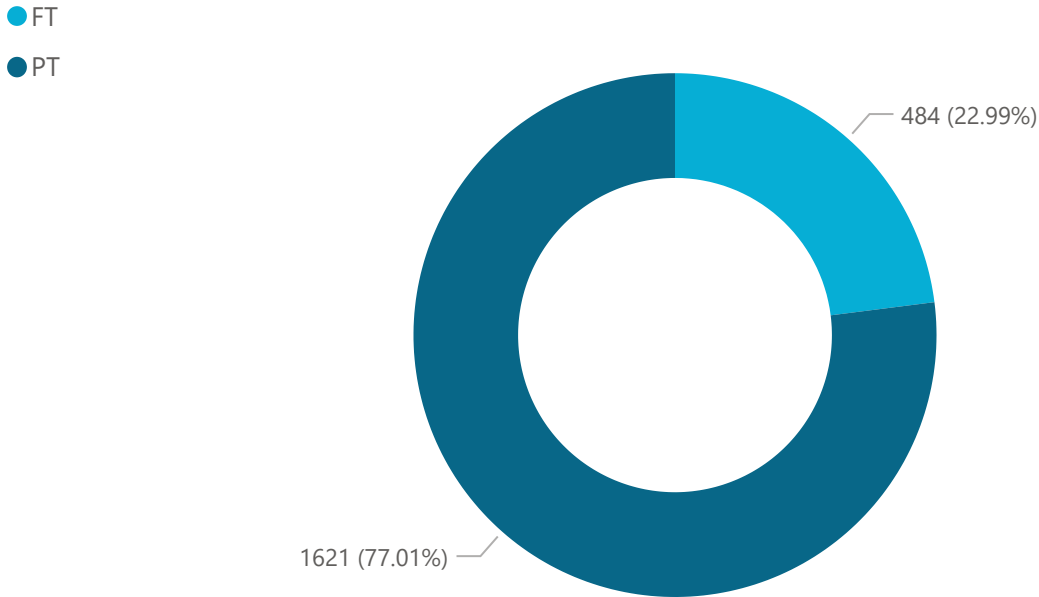

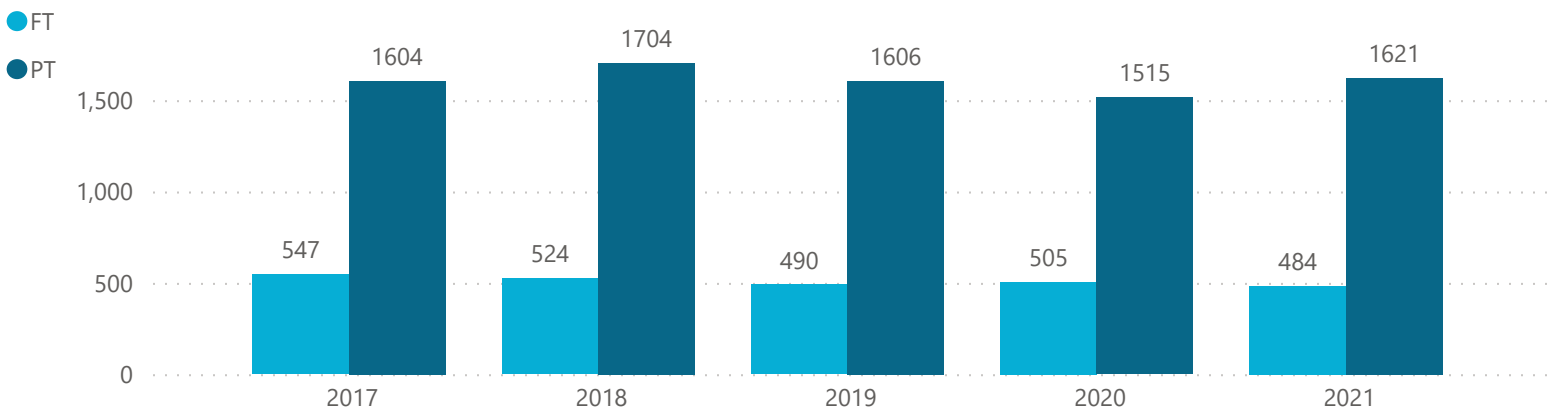

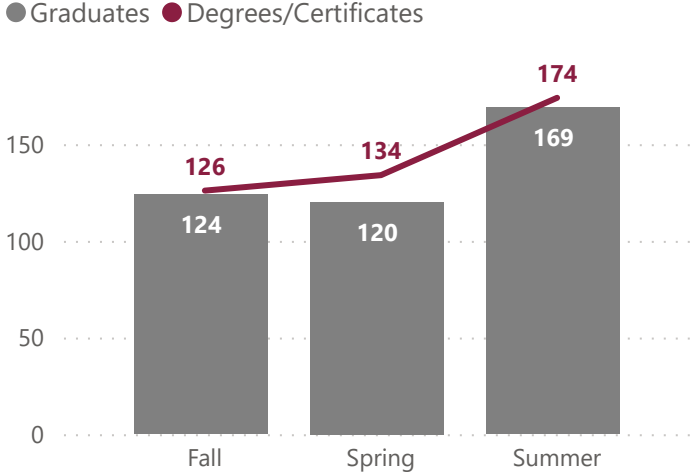

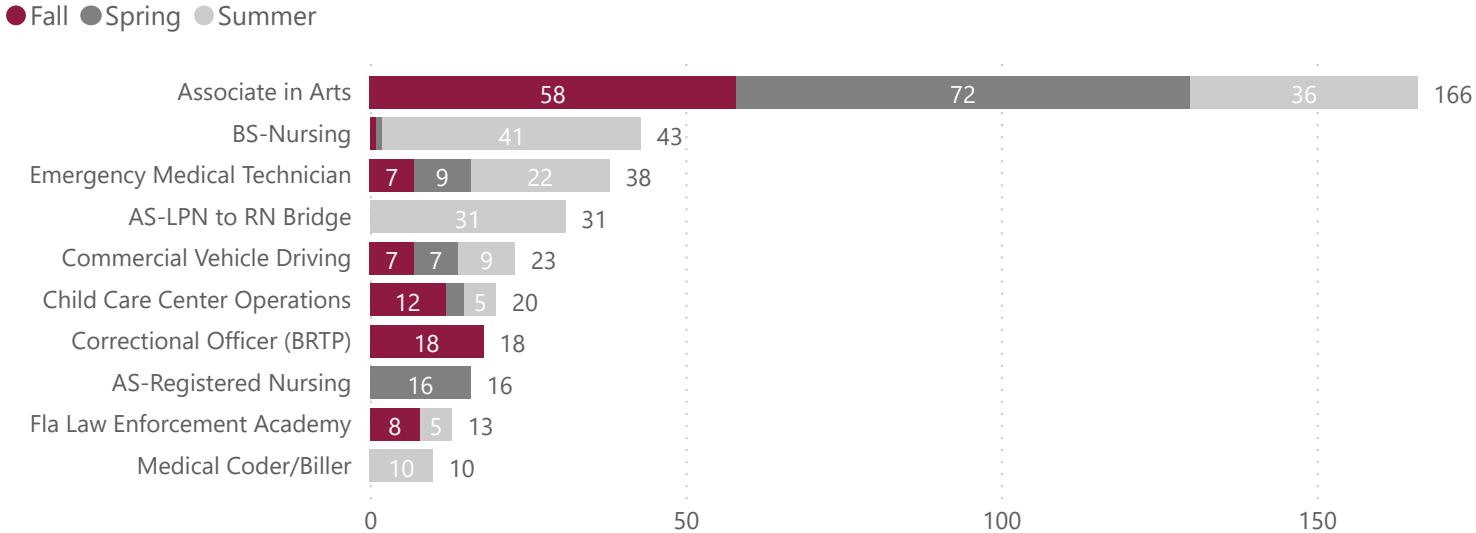

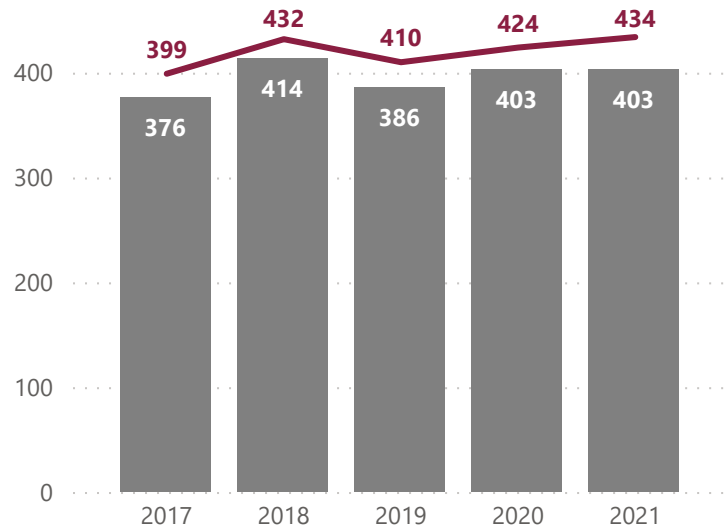

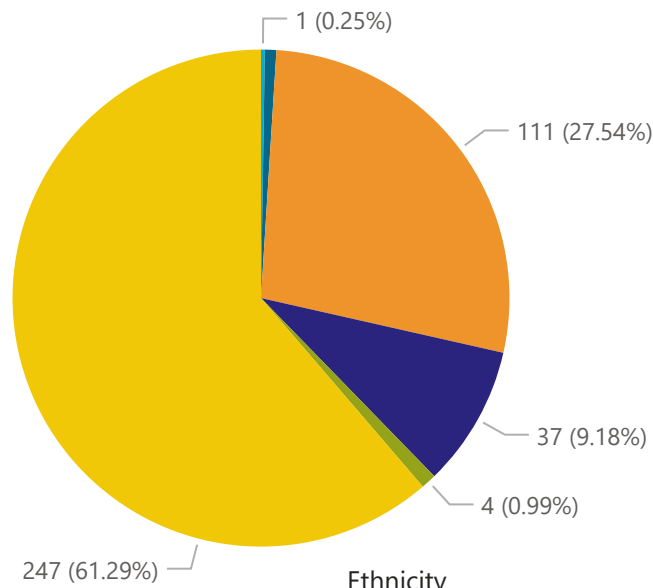

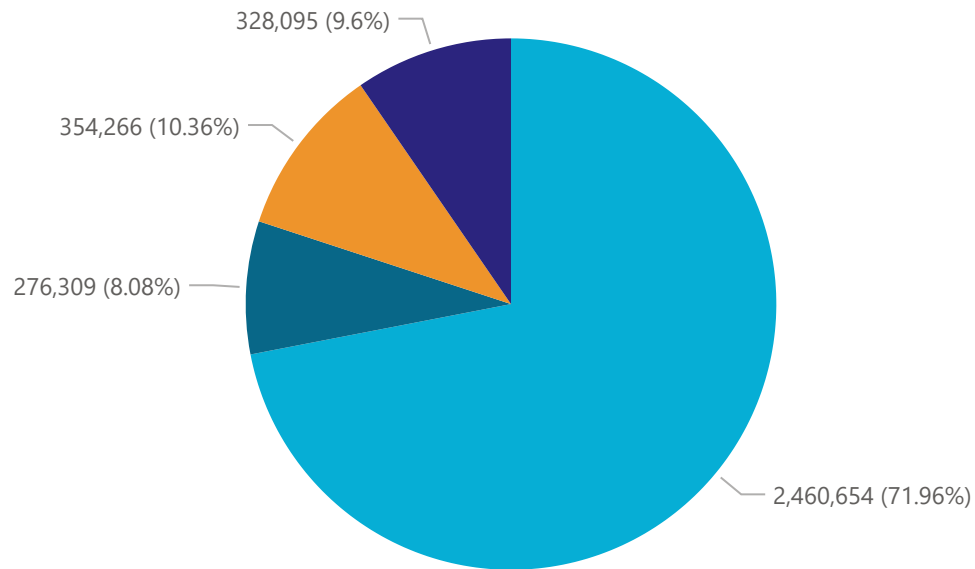

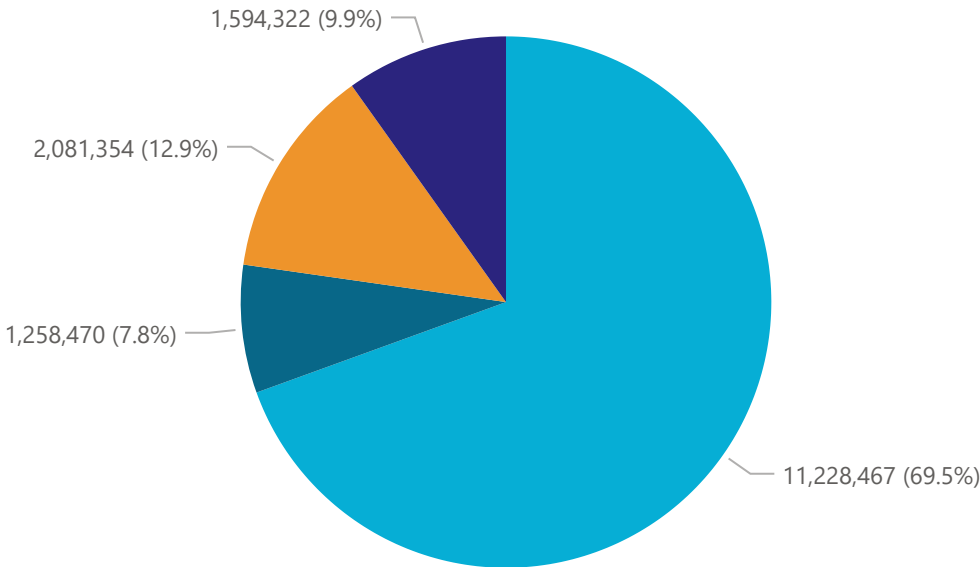

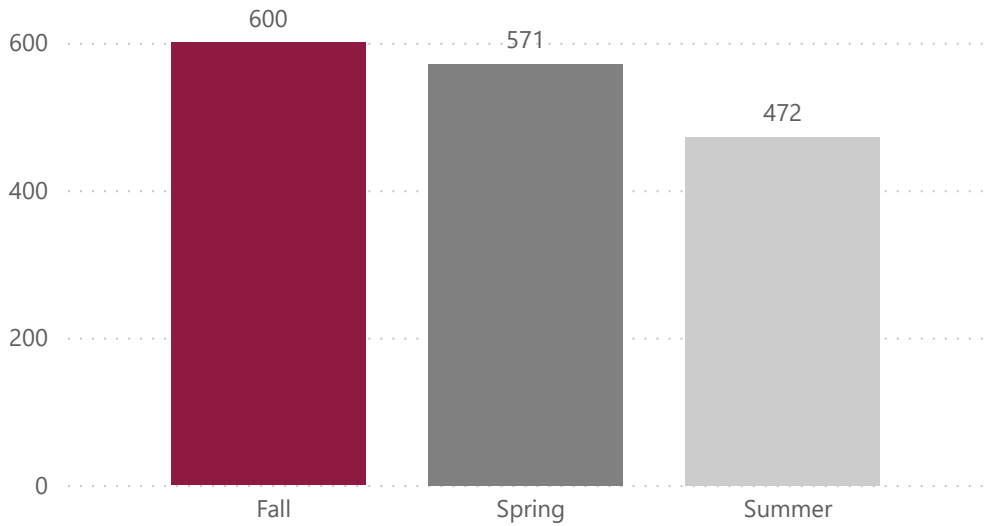

Percent Enrolled Receiving Financial Aid by Gender



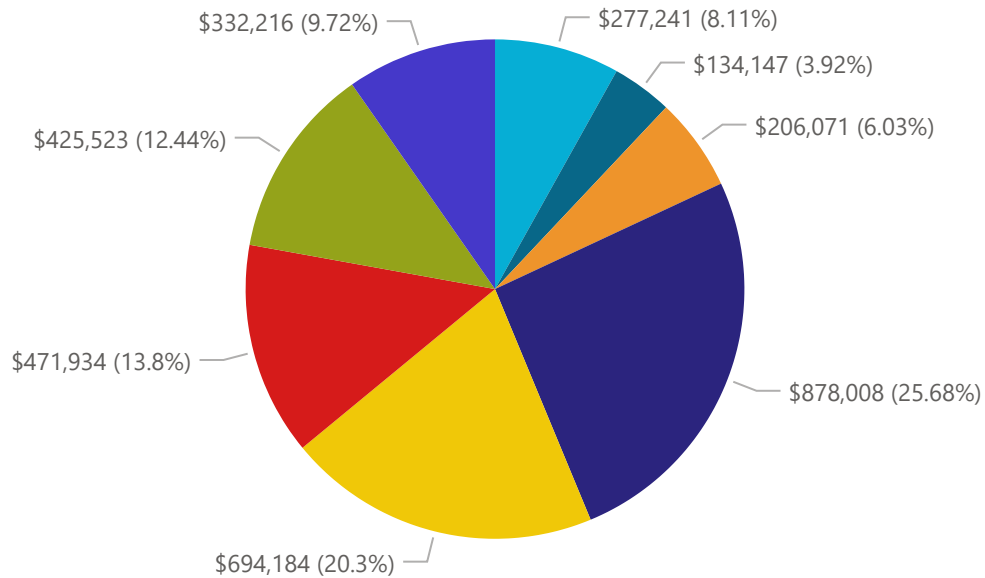

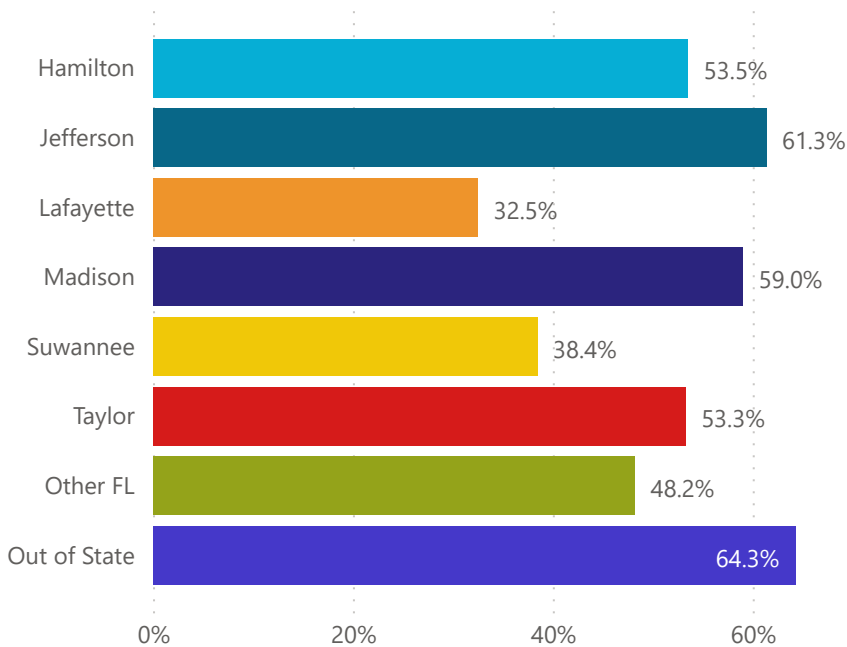

Percent Enrolled Receiving Financial Aid by County



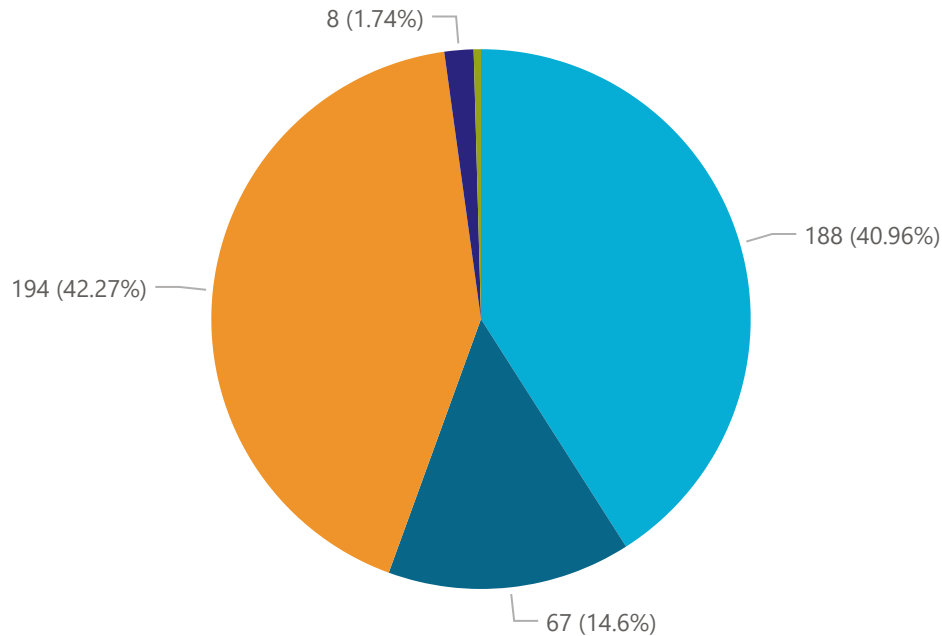

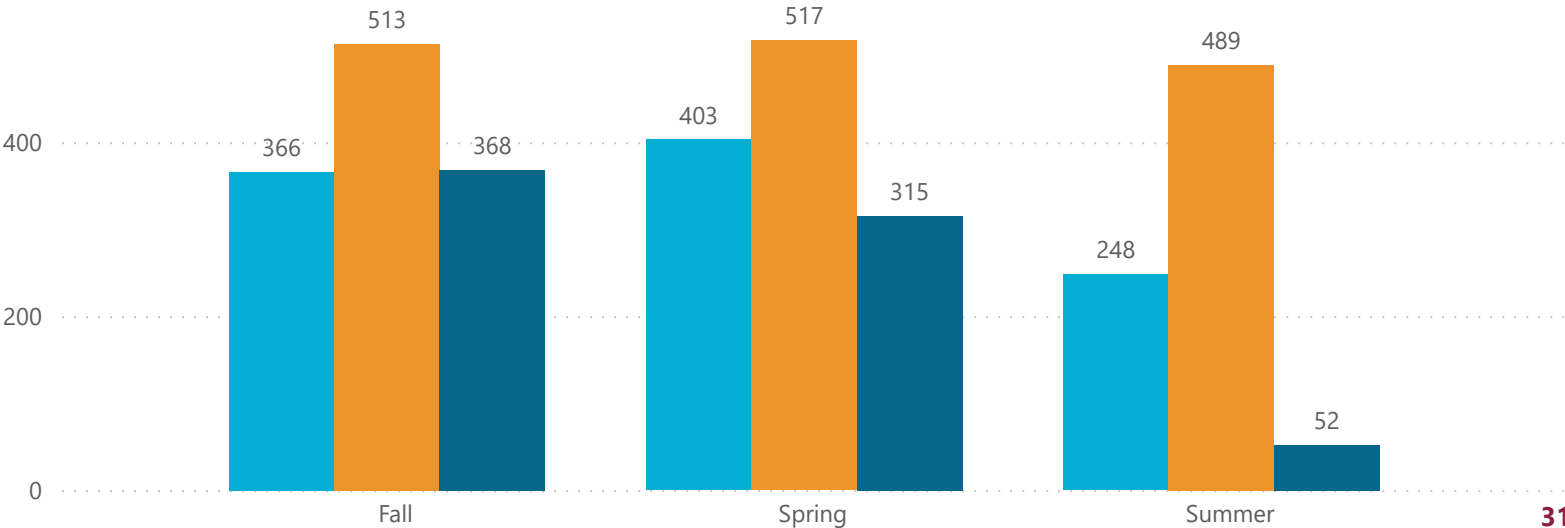

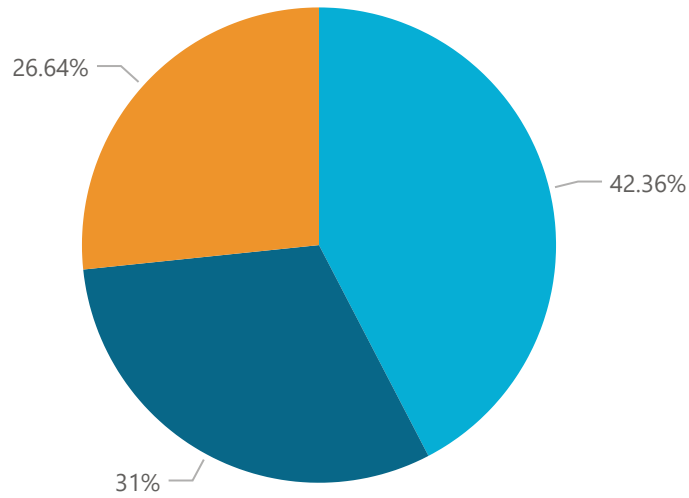

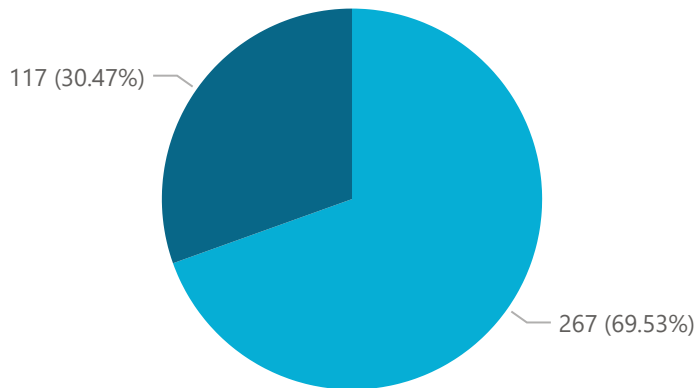


Full-Time vs Part-Time Instruction

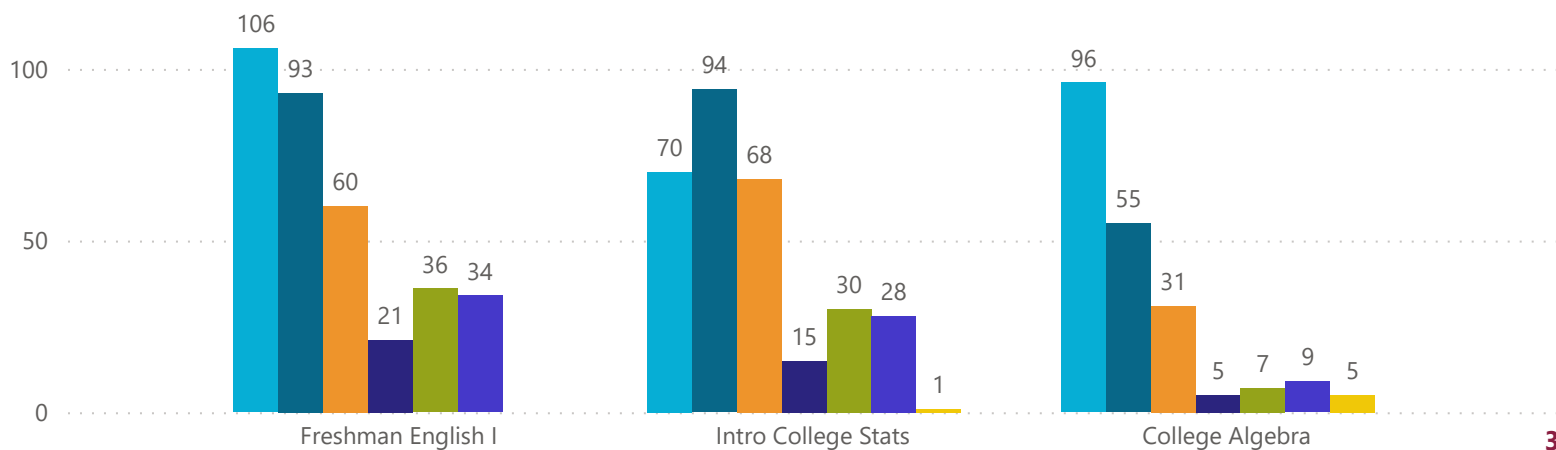

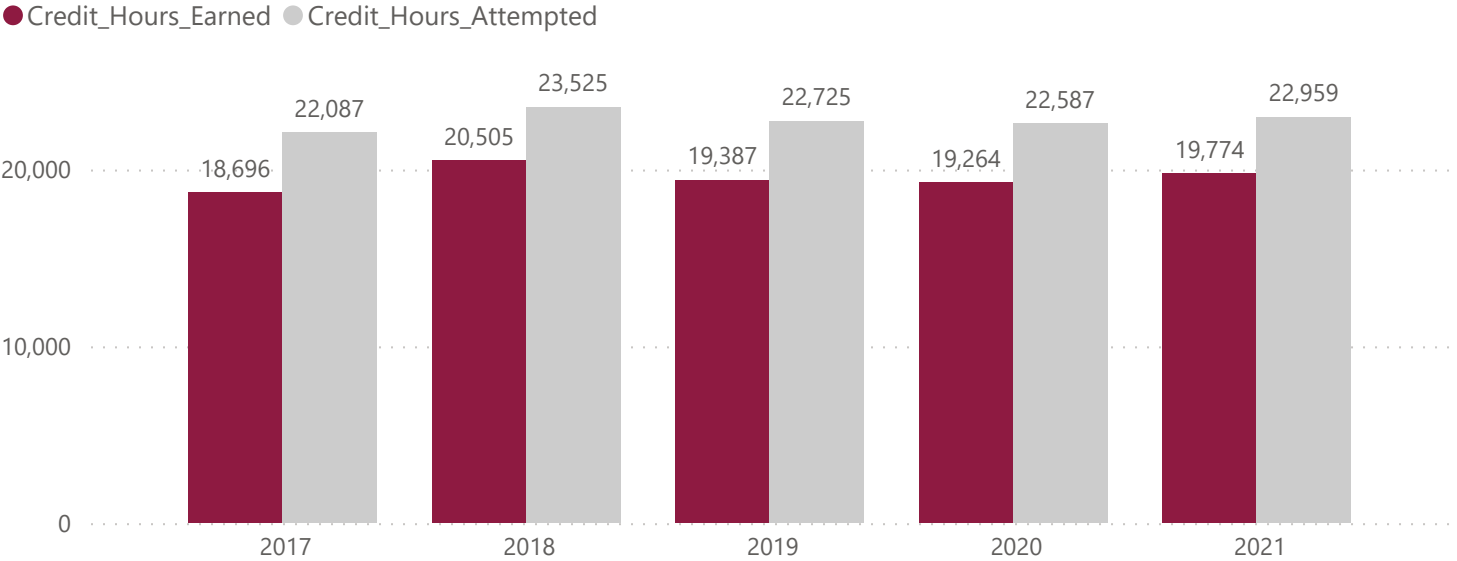

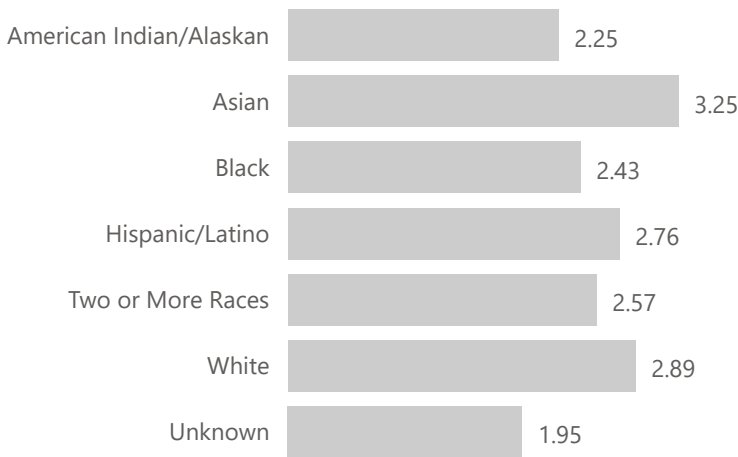
Average of Overall Term GPA by Term

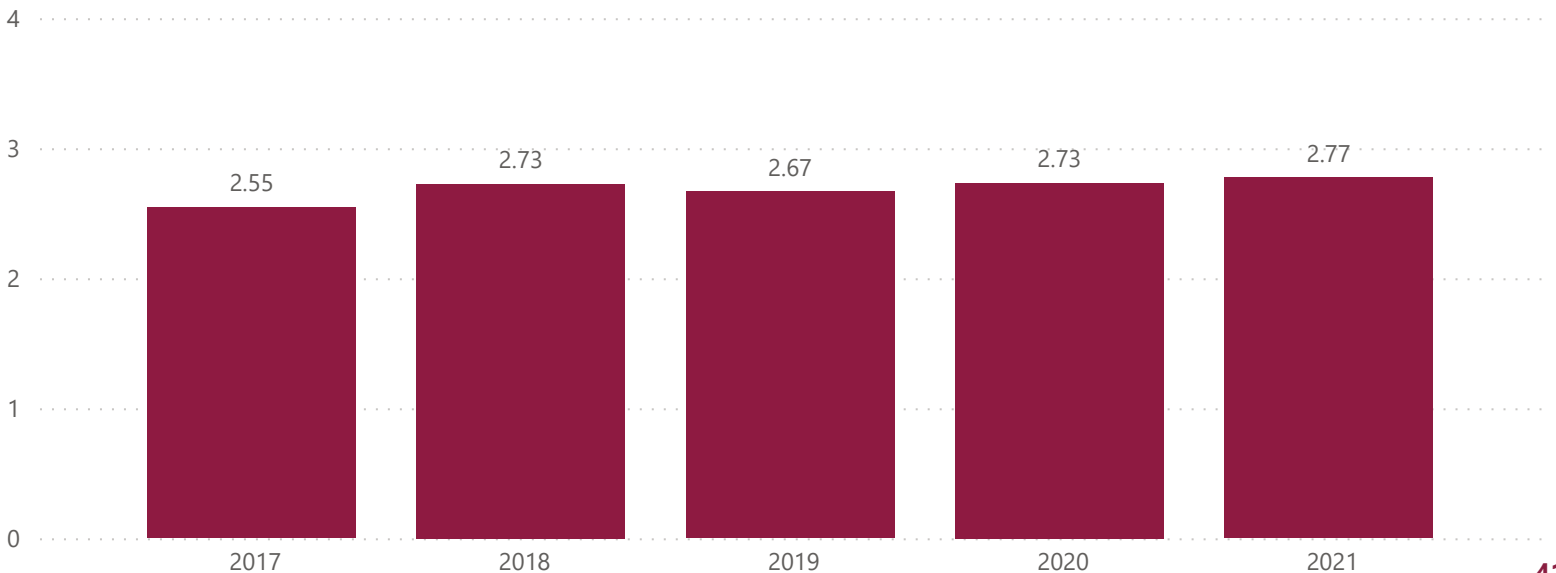
Average Overall Term GPA by Ethnicity
